The Lake Murray Coast Guard Auxiliary is offering a free boating safety course, <u>Boat America</u>, for anyone who wants to learn about the fundamentals of safe and responsible boating. Coast Guard Auxiliary instructors will teach the online course using Zoom over three consecutive evenings on February 15, 16 and 17 from 6:30 to 8:30 pm.

Students who complete the entire course and pass the exam will earn the South Carolina Department of Natural Resources Boater Education card. Textbooks for the course are important and available for \$15.00 in the <u>Boating</u> <u>Course Payment</u> menu option at <u>www.uscgaux-lakemurray.com</u>. The textbook and SC DNR Boating Handbook will be mailed to your address. Boater education is necessary to reduce loss of life, personal injury and property damage while increasing boating enjoyment. Boaters under 16 years of age are required by law to pass an approved boating education course before operating, without supervision, a personal watercraft (jet ski) or a boat powered by a motor of 15 horsepower or more. Completing a boater education course promotes knowledge of boating laws and increased safety awareness. Check with your insurance agent to see if you're eligible for a boating course completion discount for your boat or PWC insurance.
